My name is Rev. Laraine Waughtal and I am the pastor at FUMC, DeRidder, La. We are a growing and thriving congregation that has people of all ages in our congregation. DeRidder is the parish seat and we have a number of military families as a part of our congregation who serve at Fort Johnson.

We are searching for an on-line student who has a desire to be in ministry in DeRidder, LA through being a license local pastor, student pastor, Deacon or even the desire to be commissioned and ordained. This position is multi-faceted. Primarily, the position is Children, Youth and Family Ministry with the opportunities to preach, make pastoral/hospital ministry and to learn about committees and the work of the church if your calling is for ordained ministry. The hours are just under ¾ time – allowing time for studies and school.

Like many churches, we continue to regrow our worship post-covid which is over 100. This church thrives in outreach and missions and family ministries. We have an active Children's Church (anywhere from six to twenty kids depending on the weekend) on three out of four Sundays a month. Our children help lead in worship by being acolytes and leading the Lord's prayer each week. Our children are also active in Sunday School and Wednesday night supper and activities. We have a pre-school that has 84 students and an after-school program in the 20's with plenty of room for growth. Our Nursery on Sunday has anywhere from 3-6 children. We also host and work monthly with an active homeschool program. Our main campus has the original sanctuary, which is now a Fellowship Hall, classrooms, the pre-school, full size gym, playground, the office and the main sanctuary. Across the street is our youth building with a very large storage building, 24 passenger bus, 15 passenger van and large parking lot. Our secondary campus is only a half-mile away which also has a large building that is multi-use, and a two story education building on over an acre of land.

The Louisiana Conference has a very active camp program with a number of our kids going to summer camp.
